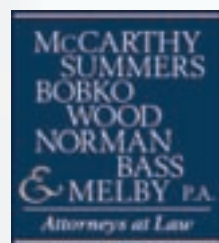

Talented soprano and Lyric favorite, Lorrianna Colozzo, is back again. Featuring some of the opera world's most recognized compositions *A Night at the Opera* is a perfect way to start off The Lyric season. Lorrianna will amaze you with her powerful renditions of classic arias from major opera productions including *Madame Butterfly*, *Barber of Seville*, and *Carmen*. Lorrianna Colozzo is always a Lyric favorite, bringing energy and grace to every performance.

You may remember Lorrianna Colozzo from her performances last season in *Home Again for the Holidays*, and most recently in The Lyric's presentation of *Guys and Dolls In Concert*, playing the role of Sarah Brown, where she amazed audiences with her powerful voice and impressive range. This season,

she's back again representing the Treasure Coast with style. Lorrianna began singing at the age of 12, studying under the tutelage of Helen Boatwright and Dan Marek of The Mannes School of Music. She continued her studies and graduated from the prestigious Peabody Conservatory of Music at Johns Hopkins. Lorrianna has extensive experience in opera, having performed in a number of operas nationwide, including *The Merry Widow*, *Così fan Tutte*, *The Cunning Little Vixen*, and *Falstaff*.

For *A Night at the Opera*, Lorrianna is accompanied by pianist Evan Ferrar. Originally from the Palm Beach area, Ferrar began his musical studies with Dr. Jack Jones. The talented pianist spent ten years in Ireland, working as a singer, coach and chorus master with a number of European companies including the Castleward Opera and the Royal Irish Academy of Music. Ferrar also sings locally with the Palm Beach Opera.

A Night at the Opera's mezzo-soprano is Christina Zimmer, a vocalist with extensive experience in operatic and Broadway productions. Zimmer sang the role of Julie in the 2011 production of *Show Boat* with Opera Naples, and recently, the talented singer appeared in concert with the Miami Symphony Orchestra. Zimmer received a Master of Music degree from Jacob's School of Music at Indiana University.

Tenor David Pereira was born in New York City. He has appeared in a variety of leading operatic tenor roles, nationally and internationally to great acclaim, most recently as Ernesto in Donizetti's *Don Pasquale* with Miami Lyric Opera, where he resides as a resident artist. David was part of the prestigious Des Moines Metro Opera Young Artist Apprentice program where he appeared in scenes of Bernstein's *Candide* as Candide, Count Almaviva in Rossini's *Barber of Seville*, Alfred in *Die Fledermaus* and Chevalier de la force in *Dialogues of the Carmelites*. Throughout his opera career, David has appeared in scenes and roles including Rossini's *The Barber of Seville* as Almaviva, Donizetti's *L'elisir d'amore* as Nemorino, Verdi's *Falstaff* as Fenton, Mozart's *Die Zauberflöte* as Tamino, Massenet's *Manon* as Des Grieux, Mozart's *Così Fan*

Tutte as Ferrando, Bizet's *Carmen* as Don Jose, Flotow's *Martha* as Lionel, and special appearances with the most notable South Florida organizations such as the Florida Grand Opera, the Hispanic-American Lyric Theatre, Coral Gables Opera & Chamber Orchestra, La Sociedad Pro Arte Gratei, The Miami Master Chorale, Civic Chorale of South Florida, among many others.

Baritone Graham Fandrei is one of South Florida's most active classical singers, singing with Florida Grand Opera, Seraphic Fire, The Masterchorale of South Florida, Young Patroness of the Opera, Miami Lyric Opera and with arts organizations on both the east and west sides of the state. Mr. Fandrei attended both the New England Conservatory of Music and The Juilliard School. His performance background includes performances in Europe, Asia and he was an original cast member in the Baz Luhrmann production of *La Bohème* on Broadway. Recently Mr. Fandrei performed in Bach's *Ich habe Genug* with Miami's Mainly Mozart festival, Bernstein's *On the Town* with the Klezmer Concert Orchestra, the Brahms *Requiem* with the Ave Maria University Chorale, and Haydn's Lord Nelson mass with the Symphonic Chorale of Southwest Florida.

District Winner of the Metropolitan National Council, Lorrianna continues to sell out shows and impress audiences, earning her title as one of South Florida's most treasured sopranos. Called "captivating" by the Baltimore Sun, Lorrianna Colozzo will be sure to captivate you this November with her brilliant renditions of opera classics.

more contemporary pop melodies, Black demonstrates his deep understanding of country music history while asserting its relevance to a modern audience. Don't miss this once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to hear country music legend Clint Black perform some of his

greatest hits in a remarkably intimate setting. Beginning his career in the early 1980s, Clint Black was immediately drawn to the traditional style of country music, inspired by major stars such as George Strait and Reba McEntire.

Working part-time as a construction worker and bait cutter while pursuing his music career, Black finally got his break in 1989 with the release of his first album, *Killin' Time*, featuring some of his most celebrated hits including "Nobody's Home," "Walking Away," and the eponymous "Killin' Time." The first single off of the album, *A Better Man*, reached the number one spot on the *Billboard* Hot Country Songs list in June of 1989, making Clint Black the first male solo artist in 14 years with a debut single at the top of the chart. *Killin' Time* immediately went triple-platinum and is now celebrated as one

of the 100 greatest country music albums of all time. Since 1989, Black has continued to have enormous success as an artist, earning over six awards, including CMA Male Vocalist of the Year, and earning a star on Hollywood's Walk of Fame.

In the late 1990s, Clint Black left his original record label to settle down and start a family. However, Black couldn't resist his calling for very long, returning to the music industry only a few years after the birth of his daughter. In 2003, Black founded Equity Music Group, an artist-friendly recording company, and began to help other aspiring young musicians enjoy the same success that he did. Equity Music Group did just that, launching the careers of a number of musical groups, most notably the country vocal ensemble Little Big Town. Aside from his music career, Clint Black has made his mark on a number of other sectors of the entertainment industry from the stage to the big screen. Black has appeared in a number of films, including *Maverick*, *Going Home*, and *Flicka 2*. Clint Black has also appeared on television in the animated series *King of the Hill* and the primetime reality TV show *Celebrity Apprentice*. More recently, the country veteran has begun developing a Broadway show celebrating the life of his longtime friend and fellow musician Roy Rogers.



Mediaeval Baebes

Enjoy a night of thrilling aerial stunts and gymnastic routines when the **National Acrobats of the People's Republic of China** (December 1, 2014; 5:00pm & 8:00pm) arrive at The Lyric Theatre this December. Straight from Beijing, the National Acrobats of the People's Republic of China are coming to Stuart for an evening of high flying acrobatic entertainment. Founded in 1951, the troupe has become one of the most acclaimed acrobatic groups in all of China, touring in over 500 cities in 70 countries across the world. In *Cirque Peking*, the National Acrobats of the People's Republic of China will demonstrate some of their most famous acts including "Aerial Bungee Tumbings" and "Global Motorcycling."

The history of the National Acrobats of the People's Republic of China is a very interesting one. Founded during the Cold War, the acrobatic troupe was unwelcome in the United States until 1972, when President Nixon invited the group to the White House. This was a major moment in the history of the relationship between China and the United States, and the company is credited in part with re-establishing diplomatic relations between the two countries at a critical period in history. Now, over four decades later, the National Acrobats are back in the United States for their 2014 North American tour.

Under the direction of Mr. An Ning, the National Acrobats of the People's Republic of China have set themselves apart from the thousands of other acrobat troupes around the world due to their professionalism and tireless innovation. Over the years, more than

200 artists from the acrobatic company have won gold and silver awards at national and international competitions as well as circus festivals. In 2012, five troupes and teams traveled to Turkey, Taiwan, Singapore, and Germany, thrilling audiences of every nationality with their breath-taking original stunts.

The National Acrobats have developed a number of impressive productions, including *Mirage*, *Pirates!*, and *Sun Birds*. This performance, entitled *Cirque Peking*, is a culmination of over 60 years of practice and dedication to the acrobatic craft. For their North American tour, the company has developed an entirely new production, featuring incredible tricks such as "Chinese Poles in Shaolin Style" and "Diving through Moving Hoops."

This December, discover some of the world's oldest holiday traditions, folklore, and melodies with the **Mediaeval**

Baebes (December 2, 2014; 7:00pm). The all-female vocal group puts a new spin on classic medieval music and poetry, singing in a variety of languages from Middle English to Mediaeval Welsh. Weaving tales of unrequited love and gothic faerieland adventures, the Mediaeval Baebes' hauntingly beautiful melodies explore universal themes while taking you on a fantastic journey through time. Beautiful, talented and witty, the Mediaeval Baebes offer an unforgettable night of Christmas music, performing classics such as "We Three Kings" and "Away in a Manger."

Founded in 1996, the Mediaeval Baebes have turned the classical music genre on its head with their witty interpretations of medieval religious and pagan songs. Founding member Katharine Blake is no music industry novice. The classically-trained vocalist enjoyed previous success as a back-up singer for experimental singer-songwriter Nick Cave and as the lead vocalist for the gothic rock group Miranda Sex Garden. Now, she devotes her time fully to Mediaeval Baebes. The group is unique for their choice to use medieval and romantic texts

as source material for many of their songs, setting the texts to original scores composed by the Baebes themselves. The vocal ensemble has released eight studio albums, three of which reached the top of the U.K. classical music charts and the Baebes have performed across the world, playing in all kinds of venues from castles to caves. In 2007, the Mediaeval Baebes received the Ivor Novello Award for Best Television Soundtrack for their contribution to the BBC production of *The Virgin Queen*.

After 18 years, the Mediaeval Baebes are still gaining momentum. Their latest album, a Christmas carol collection entitled *Of Kings and Angels*, was released in the U.K. last year. The album reached the top 10 spot of the U.K. classical charts almost immediately upon release. Released this year in the United States, the album is expected to continue to enjoy great success, particularly as the holiday season approaches. The Mediaeval Baebes will be sure to highlight some of their seasonal

interpretations from *Of Kings and Angels*, as well as from their previous 2003 holiday recording *Mistletoe and Wine* this December.

Next, get in the holiday spirit with **A Darlene Love Christmas – 'Love for the Holidays'** (December 8, 2014; 7:00pm). In her Lyric debut performance, Darlene Love will ring in the Christmas season in

Construction for The "first" Lyric began on Osceola Avenue near Belle Flora and opened for its first performance a year later.

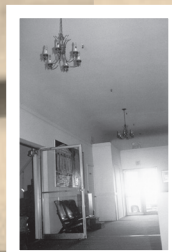

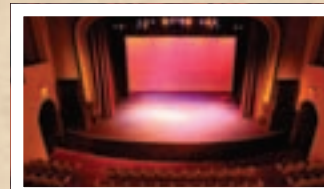

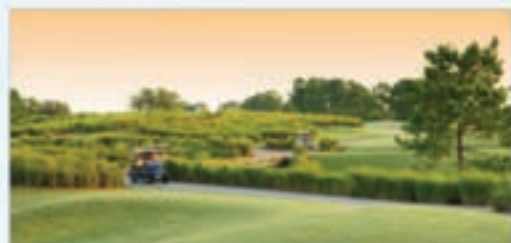

before finding his calling in the guitar. White was initially inspired by the early success of major rock groups such as the Beatles and the Rolling Stones and developed a passion for the electric guitar. When an accidental fire destroyed his electric, Peter picked up the acoustic and never looked back. Drawing upon the recordings of James Taylor, Joni Mitchell, and Crosby, Stills & Nash for inspiration, Peter White developed his skills on the acoustic guitar and earned his first professional gig at the age of 19. At the age of 21, White was invited to join folk singer-songwriter Al Stewart's band as a keyboardist during their tour through England, Scotland, and the United States. On this tour, White had the opportunity to open for a number of major artists including Billy Joel, Queen, and Linda Ronstadt. Peter White and Al Stewart's collaboration led to the major hit of 1976 "Year of the Cat."

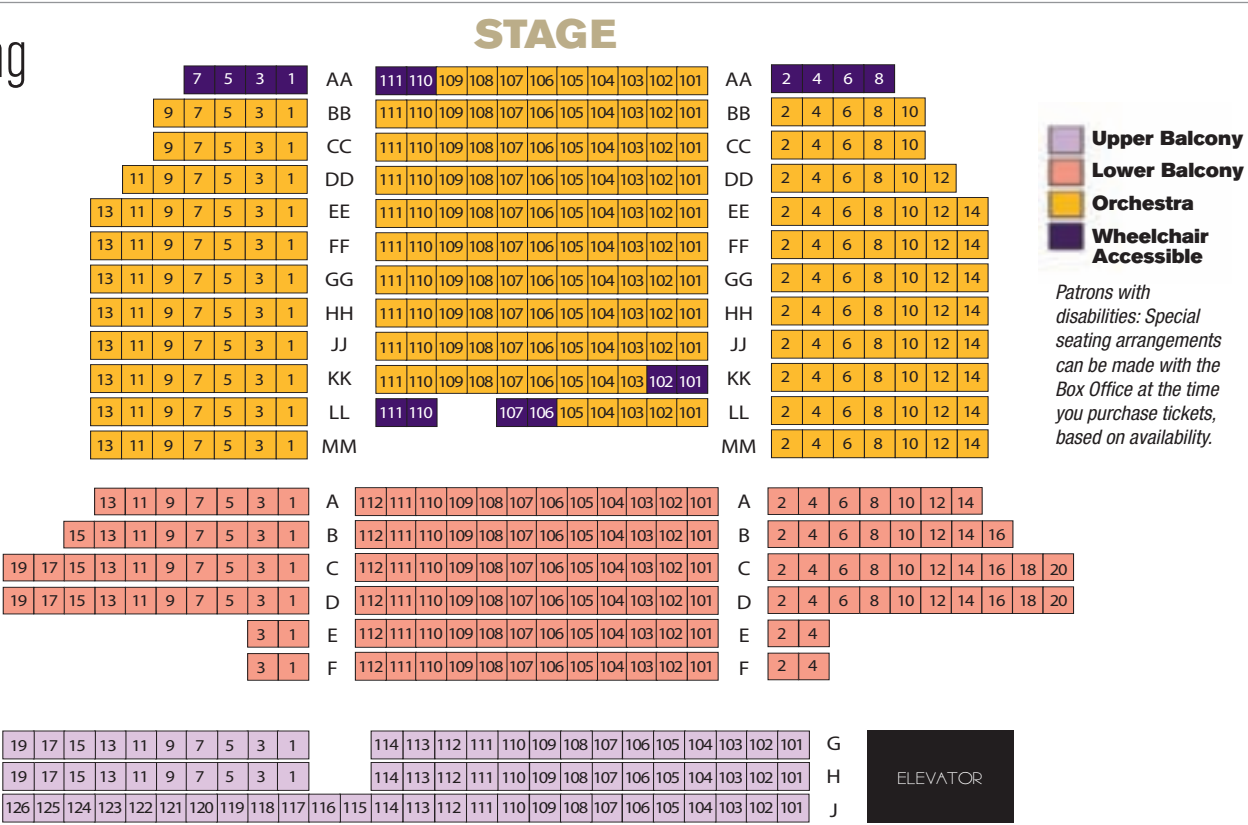
Joining Peter White for *A Peter White Christmas* are jazz musicians Rick Braun and Mindi Abair. A multi-instrumentalist and smooth trumpet player, Rick Braun began his career playing as a session musician for several bands. Braun has released over 15 albums in his career, including a Christmas album entitled *Swingin' in the Snow*. Peter White's long-time collaborator, Mindi Abair, is an accomplished saxophonist and vocalist who has toured with some of the most successful recording artists of all time, including Duran Duran, The Backstreet Boys, and Aerosmith, to name a few. Her latest album, *Wild Heart*, featured guest recordings by Gregg Allman, Joe Perry, and Booker T. Jones. In *A Peter White Christmas*, Abair will be performing some songs from *Wild Heart* as well as some holiday favorites, such as "Silent Night" and "White Christmas."

In 1990, Peter White broke away from his position in Al Stewart's band as a session guitarist and embarked on his own solo career. White enjoyed immediate success with the release of his first album, *Reveille-Vous*, which incorporated several unused songs written previously during his collaboration with Stewart. In 1996, Peter White signed on with Columbia Records to produce his next album entitled *Caravan of Dreams*. With these first two major hit albums, White had made a name for himself in the contemporary jazz scene. Now, with over 13 solo albums to his name, Peter White has just completed his latest album, *Here We Go*, which marks White's first recording with the legendary saxophonist David Sanborn. As a solo artist, Peter White has toured around the world, appearing in venues from performing arts centers to cozy nightclubs. Inspired by the success of his holiday albums *Songs of the Season* and *A Peter White Christmas*, White has designed his very own *A Peter White Christmas Tour*, featuring the musician's unique takes on traditional holiday tunes.

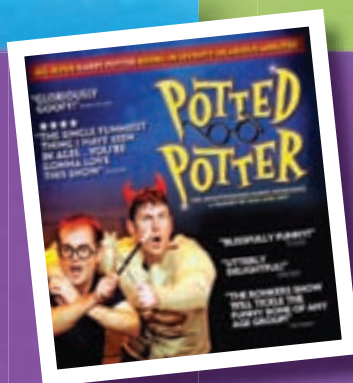

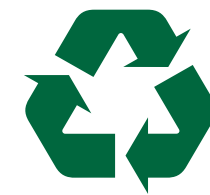
