

Moving from disco to swing, The Lyric presents **SWINGTIME featuring the Jive Aces** (March 3, 2015: 6:00pm & 8:30pm). Celebrated across the globe for their musical talent and audience engagement, the London-based Jive Aces present a night of swing, jive, and R&B. The Jive Aces cover hits from some of the music industry's greatest stars, including Louis Prima, Dean Martin, and Bobby Darin. Called "absolutely brilliant" by the notoriously critical Simon Cowell, the Jive Aces bring energy to every performance, creating an atmosphere of nostalgia and excitement.

Combining perfect technique with practiced improvisation, The Jive Aces are the U.K.'s "No. 1 Jive and Swing Band." After becoming the first band to reach the semi-finals of *Britain's Got Talent* in 2012, the Jive Aces had the honor of performing for the Queen during the Diamond Jubilee celebrations. The sextet have performed at thousands of festivals across the world, impressing audiences with a style they call "Jump Jive" music, described as a combination of swing and rock music. Over the years, the Jive Aces have worked with a number of major recording artists, including John Travolta, Chuck Berry, and Isaac Hayes. The swing group has released seven studio albums over their career so far, including an album devoted entirely to the genre of skiffle, a type of music typically performed using homemade or improvised instruments. Their latest album, entitled

Their production *Swingtime!* celebrates the greatest swing, jive, and R&B musicians of the 20th century.

Sauce Boss
Mar. 5 | 7:00pm



Things really start heating up when the **Sauce Boss** (March 5, 2015: 7:00pm) comes to town. Arrive with an empty stomach and a hankering for the blues and the Sauce Boss will deliver. The one-man band and Florida legend is back again at The Lyric Theatre for a night of swamp-style slide guitar and local storytelling. On his '53 Telecaster and 1948 Fender amp, the Sauce Boss will perform some of his most famous hits, including "Great Big Fanny" and "Let the Big Dog Eat," while cooking up a big pot of his world-famous gumbo. Featured on

NPR's *All Things Considered* and The Food Network's *Extreme Cuisine*, the Sauce Boss is taking on the world one mouth and two ears at a time.

The Sauce Boss has always had a love for music. The Orlando native started performing at the age of 14, playing in nightclubs and coffeehouses by the age of 17. But it wasn't until one day in the 1970s when he woke up one morning to find a 1933 National Steel guitar in his front yard that he really began to devote himself completely to the blues. The Sauce Boss began to draw international attention after the success of his release "Let the Big Dog Eat," which was featured in the 1986 Jonathan Demme film *Something Wild*.

Since then, the Sauce Boss has become famous for more than just his musical talent. The Sauce Boss developed his signature performing style over the years, which he maintains to this day, incorporating his crowd-rousing blues music with a very different kind of skill: cooking. In every performance, the Sauce Boss cooks a mean pot of spicy gumbo for his audience onstage all while playing some good, old-fashioned blues. The Sauce Boss

gained the recognition of Jimmy Buffet and Parrotheads everywhere with the release of Buffet's 1999 hit, "I Will Play for Gumbo," which references the Sauce Boss' distinctive performance style. His unique mix of music and food has been featured in a number of major television shows, radio programs, and magazines, including notably *Living Blues*, *GQ*, and *Gourmet Magazine*.

When he's not performing for sold-out audiences across the country, the Sauce Boss is giving back to the community. The Sauce Boss has cooked for over 190,000 people for free throughout the United States while playing his homegrown, blues-inspired set. In 2003, the Sauce Boss created the non-profit foundation "Planet Gumbo," through which he donates performances and delicious gumbo to homeless shelters around the country. This year, the Sauce Boss returns to his Florida roots at The Lyric Theatre. As always, expect a tasty meal and a savory blues performance from the Sauce Boss. Partial proceeds to benefit the Salvation Army of Martin County.

Up next is the beloved country-rock group **Pure Prairie League** (March 6, 2015: 7:00pm). With hits like "Amie" and "Let Me Love You Tonight," Pure Prairie League has earned their place as a country rock legend. After a decade of silence, Pure Prairie League was reborn in 1998 and have continued touring ever since. Credited with bringing country rock music to a national audience in the 1970s, Pure Prairie League has continued the tradition, selling out shows across the United States to audiences young and old.

Formed in the late 1960s, Pure Prairie League got their name from the fictional temperance union referenced in the 1939 cowboy film *Dodge City*, starring Errol Flynn. Following their initial success in Cincinnati, Ohio, Pure Prairie League

Finally, in 1988, the group decided to take a break from touring altogether. Ten years later, Pure Prairie League was back again and better than ever. Although their members have changed over the years, Pure Prairie League has maintained their dedication to providing authentic country rock to audiences around the world. Their most recent member, Scott Thompson, joined the group in May of 2012. At The Lyric Theatre this season, Pure Prairie League will perform some of their greatest hits.

1917

MAY 27, 1925
Construction of The "new" Lyric Theatre commenced on Flagler Avenue

MARCH 15, 1926
The "new" Lyric Theatre opened to the public with the feature picture "Skinner's Dress Suit"



NOVEMBER 29, 1930
Newly equipped with RCA Photophone sound picture machines, The Lyric Theatre opened with railroad thriller "Danger Lights" (picture with sound)

1941
The Lyric Theatre fell on hard times after the depression and closed its doors. Over the following years, it

was rented out to community groups and was used to present traveling vaudeville shows, news weeklies and movies

1978
The Lyric was purchased by New Life in Christ Church and served as a venue for weekly services

After school, Black worked at the West Bank Café's Downstairs Theatre Bar, developing his own plays and the works of others. Finally, in the late 1980s, Lewis Black realized his

true calling: stand-up comedy. In 1996, Black got his first big break, receiving national attention for a three-minute ranting segment for the *Daily Show with John Stewart*. This short segment would develop into one of the most popular segments on the show, "Back in Black."

Since 1996, Lewis Black has become one of the most cherished stand-up comedians working today. Black has produced four Comedy Central specials and a number of HBO specials, including the 2007 special "Red, White, and Screwed," which was nominated for an Emmy in 2007. Over the years, Lewis Black has appeared on the *Larry King Live*, *The Late Show with David Letterman*, and *Late Night with Conan O'Brien* among others. Lewis Black has also written two best-selling books, "Nothing's Sacred" and "Me of Little Faith," both of which became *New York Times* Bestsellers. The comedian has also appeared in major motion pictures, including *Accepted*, *Unaccompanied Minors*, and *Man of the Year* with Robin Williams. Despite his success writing and film acting, his heart still belongs to the stage. Lewis Black performs over 200 nights a year for sold-out audiences across the world.

Back again by popular demand is **Earl Turner's Box of 45s** (March 16, 2015: 7:00pm). A favorite last season, *Earl Turner's Box of 45s* is back for another night of 70s rhythm and blues. Earl Turner made his performing debut at the tender age of 13 and never looked back. Initially working as a back-up

musician, Turner got his start traveling around the United States with a variety of show bands. By the 1980s, Earl Turner had established a name for himself as a solo recording artist with the release of his top 40 dance hit "Love Caught You by Surprise." Turner has performed in dozens of major hotel casinos across the United States, including Caesars Palace, The Paris Hotel and Casino, and The Hilton Atlantic City. As a celebration of his contribution to the entertainment industry, Harrah's New Orleans dedicated the former Mansion Ballroom to Turner, renaming the space "The Earl Turner Theatre."

Over his music career, Earl Turner has performed with a number of major artists, including Gladys Knight, K.C. and the Sunshine Band, and Lou Rawls. Aside from being named "Male Vocalist of the Year" by the *Las Vegas Review Journal*, Turner was declared one of the "People to Watch" by *New Orleans Magazine*. The multi-talented musician also dedicates a significant portion of his time to supporting charities, such as The Special Olympics and The Blood Center of Louisiana. Most recently, Turner has begun working on a brand new album which he plans to release later this year. Partial proceeds to benefit the House of Hope.

Then, in **Visions from Cape Breton and Beyond: A Celtic Family Celebration starring Natalie MacMaster and Donnell Leahy** (March 19 & 20, 2015: 7:00pm) prepare to be taken on a journey across the coastline of Nova Scotia as the fiddling family explores their Celtic roots. Individually celebrated as two of the greatest fiddlers in the world,

MacMaster and Leahy have now come together and combined their talents in this breathtaking musical performance that masterfully integrates the duo's diverse French, Celtic, and Cajun musical styles.

An award-winning Canadian fiddler, Natalie MacMaster began playing at the age of nine and released her first album, *Four on the Floor*, at the age sixteen. She has received numerous awards over her artistic career, including Artist of the Year award from the East Coast Music Association and an induction into the





the foremost doo-wop groups in American history. Famous for breathing new life into tired old romantic tunes, the Duprees have an unforgettable sound that combines the soulful harmonies of doo-wop with the energy of the big band. Today, the Duprees features vocal legends Tony Testa, Tommy Petillo, Jimmy Spinelli and Phil Granito.

Founded in the early 1960s in Jersey City, New Jersey, the Duprees were immediately recognized for their vocal precision and innate talent by the owner of Coed Records, George Paxton. With the release of their very first single, a cover of Jo Stafford's "You Belong to Me," in 1952, the Duprees hit the top ten on the U.S. music charts. Over the next few years, the Duprees continued to write hits, producing over 40 top sellers by the late 1960s and early 1970s. Some of these hits include "Love Eyes," "Take Me As I Am," and "My Own True Love," which was an adaptation of "Tara's Theme" from the soundtrack of the film *Gone with the Wind*.

Today, the Duprees are still bringing their gorgeous doo-wop sound to audiences across the United States. The four-person vocal ensemble features original member and former guitarist Tony Testa as the current leader of the group, the always versatile Tommy Petillo, the suave and professional Jimmy Spinelli, as well as the show-stopping voice of Phil Granito. The Duprees are still dedicated to bringing a new vigor to timeless classics, wooing listeners of all ages with new takes on famous love songs.

If you love 1960s pop, be sure to catch **Felix Cavaliere's Rascals** (March 24, 2015: 6:00pm & 8:30pm). Rock and Roll Hall-of-Famer Felix Cavaliere is perhaps known best for his role as keyboardist and singer for the 1960s pop/rock group The Rascals. With five top 20 albums, thirteen top 40 singles, and three #1 hits, Felix Cavaliere is a force to be reckoned with. As a member of The Rascals, Cavaliere released a number of timeless classics, including "Good Lovin'," "Groovin'," and "People Got to Be Free." Felix Cavaliere's Rascals features some of the original rock group's most popular hits that have become part of American music history.

Surrounded by music since birth, Felix Cavaliere dreamt of being a classical pianist until the age of 14. After his mother passed away, the aspiring artist's vision shifted towards a new trend in music and his artistic influences focused on such innovative performers as Marvin Gaye, Ray Charles, and Sam Cooke. In his early teens, Cavaliere started a band called The Stereos and quickly began developing his unique style of singing and performing. Arguably the Rascal's biggest hit in their career, "People Got to Be Free," was written by Cavaliere himself as a response to the then recent assassinations of both Martin Luther King, Jr. and Robert F. Kennedy. By the 1970s, the Rascals' sound had shifted, incorporating elements of jazz and psychedelic rock. By 1972, the group had disbanded.

Felix Cavaliere's solo career began in the mid-1970s with a series of singles as well as albums. Over his career as a solo artist, Cavaliere released five albums. The latest release, the 1994 album *Dreams in Motion*, explored the tumultuous feelings of falling in love. In 1997, Felix and the Rascals were inducted into the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame, and in 2009, Felix Cavaliere was also inducted into the Songwriter Hall of Fame as a celebration of his gift for lyric and melody. Felix Cavaliere's Rascals revisit the sounds of the 1960s, performing some of the most popular pop/rock hits of the time period.

Next, don't miss **The Texas Tenors** (March 25, 2015: 6:00pm & 8:30pm). Swiftly becoming the most popular vocal group in America, The Texas Tenors will bring their unique fusion of country, Broadway, and classical styles to The Lyric Theatre this March. As a Top Four finalist on the wildly popular show *America's Got Talent* in 2009, The Texas Tenors became the highest ranking vocal group in the show's history. Since their television debut, the three tenors have grown their fan base to incredible numbers, having performed more than 600 shows in over 20 countries including the UK and China. Named *Billboard's* Classical Crossover Group of the Year, The Texas Tenors provide a quality show perfect for all ages.

Originally from Branson, Missouri, each member of The Texas Tenors brings a different musical background and style to the group. With JC Fisher's country music roots, Marcus Collins' pop vocal expertise, and John Hagen's operatic flair, The Texas Tenors are a breath of fresh air in the genre of Classical music. Their latest album, *You Should Dream*, was produced by the Academy Award and Grammy-nominated producer Nigel Wright. Featuring a 65-piece orchestra, *You Should Dream* was named as a *Billboard* Top 10 Album and has already sold 60,000 copies since its release in 2013. As a follow-up to the album's success, The Texas Tenors filmed a PBS special in November of 2013 in which they performed a number of songs from the release including "Unchained Melody," "Bless the Broken Road," and "Oh Shenandoah."

Despite their rising fame, The Texas Tenors continue to stick to their roots. When they're not touring internationally, the three tenors still perform at the Starlite Theatre in Branson, Missouri where they got their start. Proudly self-produced and managed, The Texas Tenors also dedicate

a great deal of their time to working with charities. The crossover classical group is partnered with organizations such as Homes For Our Troops and Child Fund, and have designed their own patriotic show entitled *Let Freedom Sing*, which celebrates heroes of America at home and abroad. This season at The Lyric Theatre, The Texas Tenors will perform some of their greatest original songs and covers from "My Way" by Frank Sinatra to "Mountain Music" by Alabama.

Back at The Lyric this March is **Doc Grober and the Mudcats performing "A Tribute to Lois Armstrong"** (March 26, 2015: 7:00pm). This time around Doc Grober and the Mudcats are celebrating the life and music of one of the most influential jazz performers of all time. Before Doc Grober became a physician, he got his start in the music industry, performing as a pianist in a Pennsylvania band called Ron Grober's Quaker City Rhythm Kings. The group enjoyed success as a touring group, performing for audiences from New York to Philadelphia. However, the Doc put his musical passion on hold as he pursued a professional career in medicine, eventually earning his degree as an orthopedic surgeon. As talented with a scalpel as he was with the piano, Doc Grober received the honor of becoming the Florida team physician for the St. Lucie and New York Mets.

Eventually, Doc Grober returned to his first love, music, after being invited to per-

form at the Pelican Yacht Club in Ft. Pierce. The Doc organized a group of some of South Florida's most talented jazz musicians to perform at the club, and they've been touring ever since. Giving his jazz ensemble the name of The Mudcats, Doc Grober and the gang have been delighting audiences across Florida for years. Now, Doc Grober and the Mudcats return for an evening celebrating the life and professional achievements of jazz legend Louis Armstrong in *A Tribute to Louis Armstrong*.

Finally, in April, The Lyric welcomes **Poco** (April 11, 2015: 6:00pm & 9:00pm). The brainchild of Buffalo Springfield members Richie Furay and Jim Messina, Poco boldly paved the way for country rock music. Blending southern twang, delicate vocal harmonies, and toe-tapping rhythms, Poco continues to draw audiences of all ages and backgrounds. With hits like "Crazy Love" and "Heart of the Night," Poco has established their reputation as one of the defining country rock bands of the 20th century.

After the widely popular American-Canadian rock band Buffalo Springfield broke up in 1968, members Richie Furay and Jim Messina made it their mission to continue pushing country and rock music boundaries. Joining together with Rusty Young, Randy Meisner, and George Grantham, Furay and Messina formed Poco. With their debut album "Pickin' Up the Pieces," Poco made it clear that they were here to stay. The release received a perfect rating from *Rolling Stone* magazine and is still celebrated as one of the greatest country music albums of all time. Over the next 40 years, Poco would continue to produce innovative rock music, releasing over 24 original albums and dozens of chart-topping hits. Their 13th album, *Legend*, proved to be their most successful release of all time, achieving the ever-coveted Platinum status.

Since 1968, Poco has been on the road for over 45 years. With original member Rusty Young on guitar and vocals, Poco also features Jack Sundrud on bass, Michael Webb on keyboard, and George Lawrence on drums. In early 2013, Young announced that the group would begin the process of retirement. Reducing their bookings, Poco is now only performing a few select shows over the next year. The Lyric Theatre is proud to be one of these select venues. So, don't miss one of the last opportunities to see Poco live this April on The Lyric stage.

Citizens Against Rail Expansion is in a united effort to raise funds and awareness around a rail project that will have profoundly negative impacts on our community should it be allowed to go forward. We are referring, of course, to All Aboard Florida (AAF), which aims to build a high-speed passenger rail system between Orlando and Miami – it would also support significant freight traffic. Our group -- Citizens Against Rail Expansion in Florida (CARE FL) -- is comprised of a coalition of home owners, community leaders, elected officials and many others, and we are dedicated to fighting rail expansion in South Florida and the Treasure Coast. This includes, most notably, the AAF rail project.

CARE is hosting an international singing sensation Michael Amante at The Lyric Theatre on March 23rd, 2015. Mr. Amante's musical repertoire is quite diverse, ranging from Broadway to Jazz and High Opera. His easy command of different genres is one reason he is so universally beloved, and his nickname – “The People's Tenor” – serves as testament to his musical accessibility.

Mr. Amante will perform at The Lyric Theatre for the CARE FL fundraiser, of which 100% of the funds raised will go to CARE FL's efforts to stop AAF's rail expansion project. Our fight has great purpose, as we believe that continued rail expansion will have a significant and negative impact on the Treasure Coast and South Florida for many years to come.

Our concern has many aspects: All Aboard Florida wants to send over 32 trains a day roaring through our communities. Imagine the current back-up created by trains. Now multiply that by 32. Safety is one of our top concerns. How much more difficult will it be for a first responder to navigate that traffic. . . 32 times a day? Will parents still feel safe letting their children walk or ride bikes to school with so many trains barreling past each day? How much precious time will be lost when an ambulance needs to reach the hospital when it gets stuck behind one of 32 trains? As Dr. Michael Collins, Medical Director of Emergency Services at Jupiter Medical Center emphasized at our Oct. 7 press conference: “Every second counts.” The threat that rail expansion poses to our health, our safety and our children is unacceptable, and we will not stand for it.

In addition to disrupting street traffic, the proposed AAF rail project will also cause dangerous interruptions to boat traffic. Several bridges that would be impacted by AAF are extremely old, and already negatively and unreasonably impact waterway traffic. If AAF's plan is realized, 32 additional trains a day will be running over the St. Lucie, Loxahatchee and New River bridges – we see a lot of potential for disaster in that. Unlike cars, boats cannot be put in neutral or park. If a boat is stopped waiting for a train, it is subject to the currents in the water. Too many boats waiting in line at a bridge could become dangerous as currents move them through narrow waterways. Moreover, many of our communities depend heavily on the marine and boating industries, and any negative impacts on waterways could significantly hurt the economy.

Most important of all, perhaps, AAF's proposed rail expansion will negatively impact our *quality of life*. Our community is safe, relaxed and beautiful – that's why we live here, and we want to preserve that.
