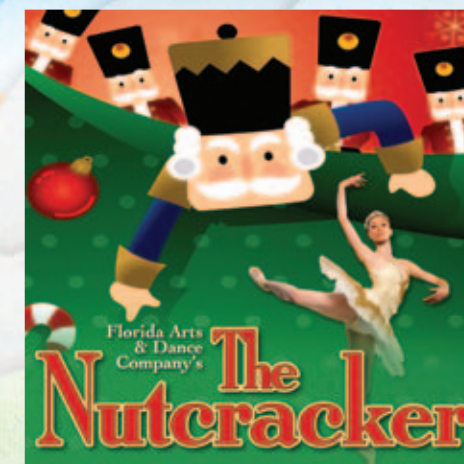

and George Hutton. Martin, described as possessing “a beautiful Italian Bel Canto quality” to his voice, studied and performed Leinster College of Music and Drama and

has performed as lead tenor in a variety of productions, including *The Lilly of Killarney* and *The Gypsy Baron*. Recipient of the Luciano Pavarotti and John McCormack awards, tenor Morgan Crowley debuted at Covent Garden’s Royal Opera House at the age of 20. Known as the “Mozart Irish Tenor,” Ciarán Kelly is a graduate of the Royal Irish Academy of Music and is a member of the renowned chamber choir ‘Resurgam.’ A graduate of University College Cork, tenor Alan Leech has performed for President Barack Obama at the White House and was named tenor to the Irish National Chamber Choir in 2002. Finally, George Hutton has performed at the Royal Albert Hall, London and in Mozart’s Mass at the National Concert Hall, Dublin. Accompanying the five tenors is pianist, composer, and arranger Feargull Murray has been called “a marvelously sensitive pianist” by the *UK Times* and has composed an award winning musical adaptation for the Royal Shakespeare Company.

From “Will You Go Lassie Go” to Mozart’s “Il Mio Tesoro,” *The 5 Irish Tenors* will explore the history of music from traditional Irish songs to classic operatic pieces in various combinations from tenor solos, duets, trios, quartets, quintets and tutti. Star of *Jersey Boys*, **Jarrold Spector “A Little Help from My Friends”** (January 16, 2017: 7:00pm), makes his Lyric debut with a captivating

performance that explores sounds of Frankie Valli from the Beach Boys to Paul McCartney. Including songs such as “When You Wish Upon a Star” and “Uptown Girl,” *A Little Help from My Friends* traces not only the musical influences of Valli himself, but Jarrod Spector’s experiences and stories after five years of playing the legendary musician on Broadway.

Originally from Philadelphia, Jarrod Spector attended the prestigious Princeton University and later studied acting at the Atlantic Theatre Company. Finding his true passion in theatre, Spector immediately gained success as a Broadway performer, appearing in *Les Miserables*, *Hamlet*, and *Our Country’s Good* among other shows. After his initial foray into Broadway, Jarrod Spector rocketed into fame in the role of Frankie Valli in the critically acclaimed show *Jersey Boys*. Since then, Spector has appeared on the Emmy and Tony Award shows, and is currently starring as Barry Mann in *Beautiful: The Carole King Musical*.

A Little Help from My Friends is Jarrod Spector’s exploration of his time as Frankie Valli in *Jersey Boys*, as the performer and celebrity investigates the sounds that influenced the legendary Four Seasons front man. Featuring a full band and back-up singers, *A Little Help from My Friends* was celebrated by the *New York Times* as a “witty, energetic mini-jukebox musical.”

A thrilling highlight of our upcoming season is celebrated soprano, **Renée Fleming** (January 31, 2017: 7:00pm), who will grace The Lyric stage, as she performs classic opera arias from her extensive repertoire. A National Medal of Arts winner, Fleming is known as “The People’s Diva,” captivating audiences around the world with her powerful vocals and commanding presence. A legendary singer known for her signature roles such as Countess Almaviva in Mozart’s *Le nozze di Figaro* and Desdemona in Verdi’s *Otello*, Renée

Fleming has been described by conductor Sir Georg Solti as one of the most incredible vocalists of all time.

Born in Indiana, Pennsylvania, Renée Fleming grew up in Rochester, New York where she was immediately recognized for her innate singing ability. Fleming studied at the Eastman School of Music, despite being asked to join the famous Illinois Jacquet on tour with his big band. Renée later won a Fulbright scholarship to study in Europe, where she continued her tutelage under Arleen Auger and Elisabeth Schwarzkopf. After studying and singing with the Juilliard Opera Center, Renée Fleming gained international recognition when she won the Metropolitan Opera Auditions at the age of 29. Fleming has continued to make a name for herself both domestically and internationally, winning a 2013 Grammy Award for Best Classical Vocal Solo for her performance on *Poemes*, a collection of 20th century French music, including compositions created especially for her by Henri Dutilleux. In addition, Renée Fleming has performed at the 2006 Nobel Peace Prize ceremony, the 2008 Olympics Games, and received the honor of becoming the first opera singer to perform the “Star Spangled Banner” at the 2014 Super Bowl game ceremonies.

Fleming has continued to impress, as she became the first woman to solo headline an opening night gala in the 125 year history of the Metropolitan Opera. She has since performed in the title role of Lehar’s *The Merry Widow* at the Lyric Opera of Chicago, where she also serves as Creative Consultant, and recently made her Broadway debut, for which she received a Drama League Award nomination. Renée is currently developing a world-premiere opera based on the best-selling *Bel Canto* for the Chicago Lyric Opera 2015-2016 season. For her performance at The Lyric Theatre this season, Renée Fleming will perform arias from some of the most famous operas of all time in an incredibly intimate space. *Proudly sponsored by Mrs. Joan McGowan and Robert P. Bauman.*

Then, get ready for a night of

groundbreaking, fast-paced a cappella this season when **Vocalosity** (February 4, 2017: 4:00pm & 7:00pm) comes to The Lyric Theatre. From the creative mind of the “Father of Contemporary A Cappella,” artistic producer Deke Sharon (*Pitch Perfect*, *The Sing-Off*), the live concert event features 12 dynamic voices singing some of today’s chart-topping hits in brand-new arrangements too incredible to miss. No genre of music is off limits in the world of a cappella and *Vocalosity* will explore them all – from tenth century Gregorian chant and classic choral, to barber shop quartet and bouncing doo-wop all the way to The Beatles and Bruno Mars. Combine that with movement and choreography from Sean Curran (*Stomp* original cast member) and you have an exhilarating evening of song unlike anything you’ve ever seen or heard, live on stage.

Vocalosity is brought to you by Artistic Producer Deke Sharon, who is internationally renowned as an a cappella singer and producer. Sharon served as arranger, on-site music director, and vocal producer for Universal’s *Pitch Perfect* and *Pitch Perfect 2* films, which starred Anna Kendrick and Rebel Wilson. Having arranged over 2,000 songs throughout his career, Deke Shannon is credited with creating the style of dense vocal instrumentation that has become synonymous with modern a cappella music. *Vocalosity* is choreographed and directed by Sean Curran, who performed in the original cast of the wildly popular physical theatre show *Stomp*.

From the sounds of 10th century Europe to the top of the contemporary *Billboard* charts, *Vocalosity* explores the limits of human sound. *Vocalosity* takes the style of singing made popular by the

band Pentatonix and shows like *The Sing-Off* to a whole new level, with its 12-part harmony and innovative arrangements. Featuring traditional vocalists as well as some of the foremost beatbox performers working in the industry today, *Vocalosity* is a show perfect for the whole family. After debuting in January 2016, the unique vocal

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE LYRIC THEATRE



SPRING OF 1913

Construction for The “first” Lyric began on Osceola Avenue near Belle Flora and opened for its first performance a year later.

1917

The “first” Lyric was abandoned and moved to a little wooden structure on Osceola Avenue

MAY 27, 1925

Construction of The “new” Lyric Theatre commenced on Flagler Avenue

MARCH 15, 1926

The “new” Lyric Theatre opened to the public with the feature picture “Skinner’s Dress Suit”



NOVEMBER 29, 1930

Newly equipped with RCA Photophone sound picture machines, The Lyric Theatre opened with railroad thriller “Danger Lights” (picture with sound)

1941

The Lyric Theatre fell on hard times after the depression and closed its doors. Over

the following years, it was rented out to community groups and was used to present traveling vaudeville shows, news weeklies and movies

1978

The Lyric was purchased by New Life in Christ Church and served as a venue for weekly services

Born in Detroit, Lily Tomlin initially enrolled at Wayne State University with the intention of studying medicine. After taking elective theater classes, Tomlin discovered her true talent and began performing in coffee houses

across the city. The aspiring comedienne moved to New York City in 1965, where she began amassing a dedicated fan base, performing at notable clubs including The Improvisation and Café Au Go Go. Lily Tomlin made her television debut in 1966 on the *Gary Moore Show*, and quickly followed this up with appearances on the famous *Merv Griffin Show*. The actress skyrocketed into fame after accepting a role on the notorious *Laugh-In* television series, where she developed such memorable characters as Ernestine, the telephone operator. Lily Tomlin has continued to grow her career, notably appearing on the *West Wing* as President Bartlett's assistant, for which she received a Screen Actors Guild nomination. The timeless Tomlin is currently co-starring with Jane Fonda in the hit Netflix series, *Grace and Frankie*.

A veteran of film as well as television, Lily Tomlin debuted in her first feature film in the role of Linnea, a gospel singer and mother of two deaf children in Robert Altman's 1975 movie *Nashville*. In addition to this Oscar-nominated performance, Tomlin has

appeared in *I Heart Huckabees*, *A Prairie Home Companion*, and *Grandma*, a film that was selected as the closing film at the 2015 Sundance Film Festival. For her role in film, Tomlin received the prestigious Crystal Award from Women in Film.

Featuring wacky musical numbers with genres as varied as swing, rock-a-billy, jazz, and country, *Pump Boys and Dinettes* is the catchiest musical you'll see all year. 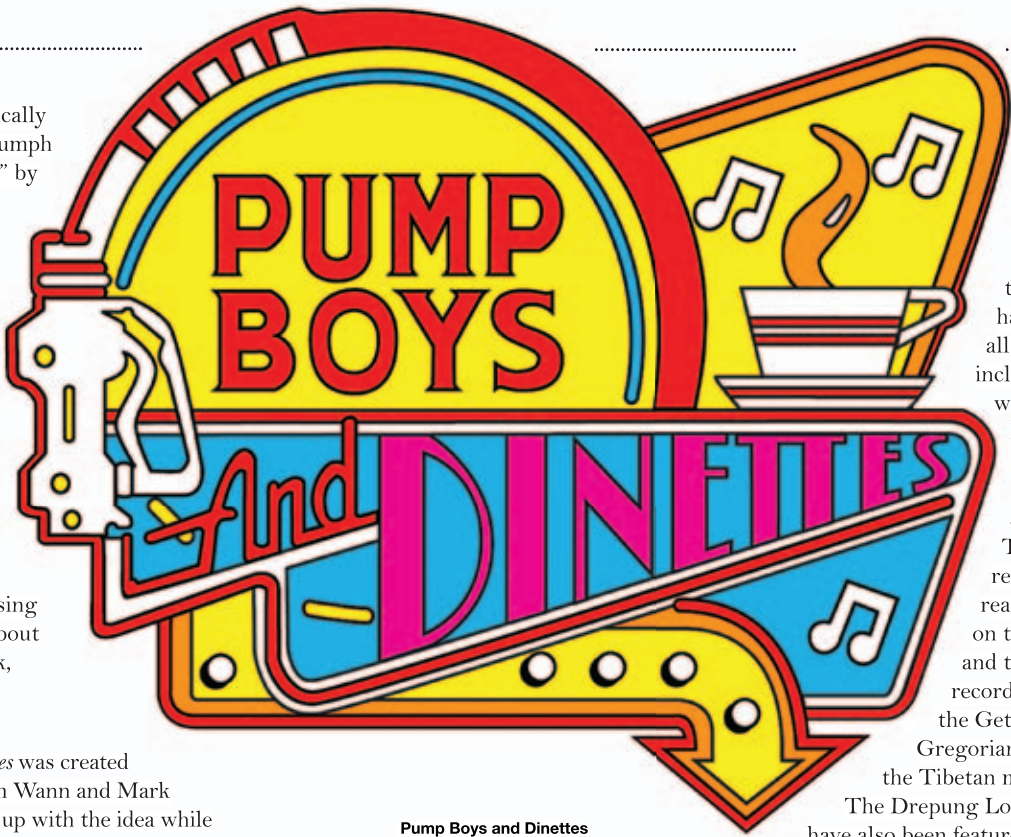

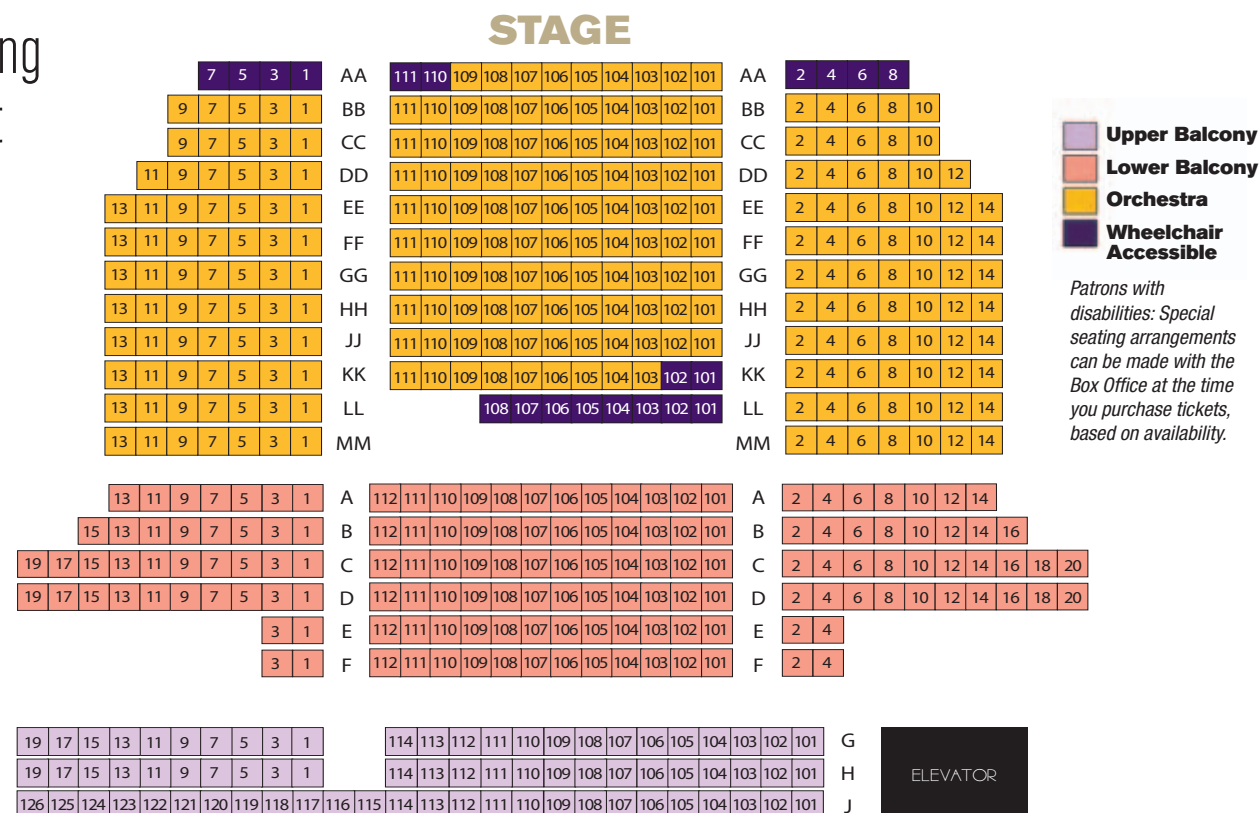

Cage aux Folles, Hello Jerry: The Music of Jerry Herman takes you on a journey through Broadway history.

Hello Jerry: The Music of Jerry Herman is the latest revue by Barry Day, who developed a number of highly successful regional shows, including *More of Loesser* and *And All That Jazz*, among others. *Hello Jerry* brings the compositions of Jerry Herman to life. Raised in Jersey City by Jewish parents in the 1930s, Jerry Herman was interested in music at an early age, learning to play piano as a child, and frequently attending Broadway musicals with his parents. After becoming involved in theatrical productions at camp, Herman dedicated himself to writing music. He got his first big break in 1964, when *Hello, Dolly!* premiered. The wildly successful musical became the longest running musical for its time, and was later revived three times. In 1983, Jerry Herman wrote another big hit, *La Cage aux Folles*, which became the only musical to win the Tony Award for Best Revival twice. In 2009, Herman received the Tony Award for Lifetime Achievement in Theatre, and in 2010, he received the Kennedy Center Honors.

Hello Jerry: The Music of Jerry Herman will feature some of Jerry Herman's greatest hits, including "I Am What I Am," "It Only Takes a Moment," and "If He Walked into My Life." Perfect for Broadway music lovers and new comers to the world of musical theatre, *Hello Jerry* is a fast-paced revue of some of the best of Broadway.

And perhaps one of the most highly coveted tickets of the season will be to experience pre-eminent violinist, **Itzhak Perlman and Rohan De Silva Collaborative Pianist** (March 7, 2017: 7:00pm) in their premiere performance at The Lyric. A 2015 Presidential Medal of Freedom recipient, Perlman is known for his exquisite renditions of classical, jazz, klezmer, and baroque pieces. Born in Tel Aviv, Israel, in 1945, Itzhak Perlman began playing music at the age of 3, when he taught himself how to play the violin using a toy fiddle until he was old enough to study at the Shulamit Conservatory under Rikva Goldgart. Perlman contracted polio when he was four years old, limiting his mobility and forcing him to play the violin while seated. An incredible musician, Itzhak quickly gained international recognition, making his debut at Carnegie Hall in 1963 and winning the Leventritt Competition in 1964. Perlman has

conducted the Detroit Symphony Orchestra as well as the Westchester Philharmonic, and teaches at the Juilliard School for their pre-college program. Itzhak Perlman's music has been featured in a number of major motion pictures, including Steven Spielberg's Oscar-winning film *Schindler's List* and the 2005 film *Memoirs of a Geisha*. In 2008, Perlman was awarded a Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award for his contribution to the recording arts.

For his performance at The Lyric Theatre this season, Itzhak Perlman will perform a collection of classical pieces, from Strauss to Mozart. The legendary musician is known for both his technical ability and the joy he brings to every performance, making every one of his concerts a truly remarkable experience. 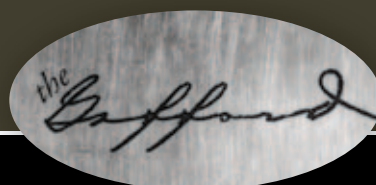
