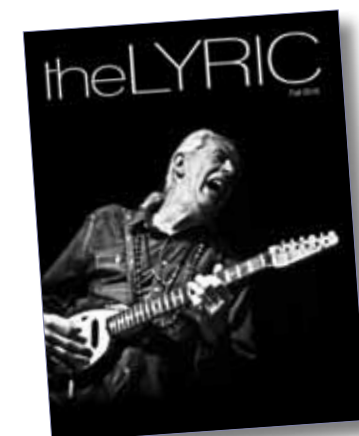

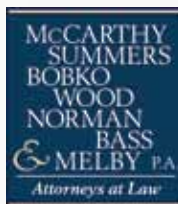

This fall, The Lyric Theatre is jam-packed with some incredible performers never before seen on the historic stage including the legendary blues musician John Mayall and DeadPhish Orchestra. From tributes to standup comedy and returning favorites, A Peter White Christmas and the Atlantic City Boys, don't miss a second of the entertainment as The Lyric wraps up the year and starts off 2017.

DeadPhish Orchestra

(October 7, 2016 8:00pm) Starting off the season this year at The Lyric Theatre is a group that jams like no other. Unlike any band you've seen before, DeadPhish Orchestra masterfully merge the music of the Grateful Dead and Phish into one unique concert experience. Through carefully crafted segues, DeadPhish Orchestra take on the folksy, bluesy sounds of the Grateful Dead and the aggressive funkiness of Phish and create a sound all their own. This season at The Lyric Theatre, the Colorado quartet will play some of your favorite songs from Bertha to Harry Hood and more.

What began as a group of friends playing some of their favorite Phish songs together in Colorado developed into one of the most unique tribute bands active today. DeadPhish Orchestra has toured across the country, from Redwood City, California to Boca Raton. The talented quartet has welcomed a number of guest musicians to perform with them, including members of the String Cheese Incident, Yonder Mountain String Band, and the Heavy Pets. Their cleverly designed performances and palpable passion for music allow audiences to experience all the best of jam music in one show.

Featuring Paul Murin on guitar, Ted Tilton on keyboards, Brian Adams on bass, and Chris Sheldon on drums, DeadPhish Orchestra will perform some of the greatest hits from the Grateful Dead and Phish on

The Lyric stage this season. With setlists that transition seamlessly between artists, such as Divided Sky > Morning Dew > Divided Sky, DeadPhish Orchestra celebrate the spontaneity and improvisation that makes jam music so memorable.

John Mayall

(October 14, 2016 7:00pm) Up next, The "Godfather of British Blues" himself will grace The Lyric stage with a night of soul quenching sound. A pioneer of blues music for over 50 years, John Mayall and his original band, the Bluesbreakers, featured some of the greatest musicians of all time, including Eric Clapton, Mick Taylor, and Mick Fleetwood to name a few. With hits such as "All Your Love," "Hideaway," and "Crocodile Walk," John Mayall has earned his place as one of the most influential blues musicians of all time.

Born in 1933, John Mayall grew up in a town outside of Manchester, England. Inspired by his father's extensive record collection, Mayall fell in love with the blues. At age 14, the aspiring musician went to Manchester's Junior School of Art where he continued his musical education, playing the guitar, piano, and harmonica. Taking inspiration from the sounds of Leadbelly, Albert Ammons, and Pete Johnson among others, John Mayall devoted himself fully to the blues. However, it wasn't until 1962, when Mayall heard that a club was opening up in Ealing dedicated to blues music that the musician finally found his calling. Mayall moved from Manchester to London and started the Bluesbreakers. With their fresh sound and raw talent, the Bluesbreakers quickly rose in popularity, and soon John Mayall would be backing John Lee Hooker, T-Bone Walker, and Sonny Boy Williamson in their first tours through England. In 1966, Mayall teamed up with the ex-Yardbird guitarist Eric Clapton for a ground-breaking album that was named one of the 500 Greatest Albums of All Time by *Rolling Stone* magazine. Although Clapton left to form the band Cream shortly after, John and the Bluesbreakers continued their success, releasing a unique drummer-less live album in 1969 that immediately achieved gold status.

In the 1970s, John Mayall moved to California where he continued working with some of the greatest contemporary recording artists. A decade later, moved by nostalgia and fan support, Mayall decided to reform the original Bluesbreakers, joining with John McVie, Mick Taylor, and a new drummer, Colin Allen, for a few tours and a video concert called *Blues Alive*. After receiving overwhelmingly positive feedback, John decided to permanently bring the Bluesbreakers back, and after a long search process, launched the new Bluesbreakers band in 1984, featuring Coco Montoya and Walter Trout. By 1993, Texas guitarist Buddy Whittington had joined, making his recording debut on the album *Spinning Coin*.

In 2005, after nearly 50 years of playing the blues, John Mayall was awarded a prestigious OBE by The Queen's Honour list. Although Mayall permanently retired the Bluesbreakers band in 2008, the veteran blues musician couldn't stay away from the stage for long, and in 2009, Mayall put together a new band to record an album with Eagles Records. His latest studio album, *Find a Way to Care*, is a testament to his enduring legacy in the world of blues. With the recent release of *Live in 1967 Volume II* and a brand new studio album in the works, John Mayall continues to reign as the "Godfather of British Blues."

show returns with Peter White, Rick Braun, and Euge Groove in *A Peter White Christmas*. Combining the unique styles of jazz, pop, and classical genres together, *A Peter White Christmas* puts a new spin on Christmas classics from "The Little Drummer Boy" to "Greensleeves." Starring veteran musician Peter White, this special holiday tradition in Martin County will also feature trumpet player Rick Braun and saxophonist Euge Groove.

Peter White started playing the electric guitar when he was a young boy, inspired in part by the music of groups like the Rolling Stones and the Beatles. When an accidental fire destroyed his electric guitar, White transitioned to the acoustic and a jazz icon was born. After receiving his first professional booking when he was only 19,

Peter White joined Al Stewart's band as a keyboardist on the famous singer-songwriter's international tour through England, Scotland and the United States. White and Stewart continued to work together over the years, collaborating on the release of the major 1976 hit, "Year of the Cat."

Performing with Peter White in *A Peter White Christmas* this year are Rick Braun and Euge Groove. Comfortable with a variety of instruments, Rick Braun has mastered the trumpet. Braun began his career as a session musician, and over the course of his career, has released over 15 albums, including a Christmas album titled *Swingin' in the Snow*. Joining Peter White and Rick Braun this year is the chart-topping saxophonist Euge Groove. Groove has played with a variety of musicians, including

Tina Turner, Luther Vandross, and Joe Cocker. His latest album, *Got 2 Be Groovin'* is a collection of nine original pieces and one cover that showcase the saxophonist's incredible creativity and diversity.

A Peter White Christmas is always a favorite among families, bringing together audiences young and old. The Christmas special was inspired by the success of Peter White's holiday albums, such as *Songs of the Season* and the eponymous *A Peter White Christmas*. This Christmas, join us again for a night of Christmas melodies with Peter White, Rick Braun, and Euge Groove.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE LYRIC THEATRE



SPRING OF 1913
Construction for The "first" Lyric began on Osceola Avenue near Belle Flora and opened for its first performance a year later.

1917
The "first" Lyric was abandoned and moved to a little wooden structure on Osceola Avenue

MAY 27, 1925
Construction of The "new" Lyric Theatre commenced on Flagler Avenue

MARCH 15, 1926
The "new" Lyric Theatre opened to the public with the feature picture "Skinner's Dress Suit"

NOVEMBER 29, 1930
Newly equipped with RCA Photophone sound picture machines, The Lyric Theatre opened with railroad thriller "Danger Lights" (picture with sound)

1941
The Lyric Theatre fell on hard times after the depression and closed its doors. Over the following years, it was rented out to

community groups and was used to present traveling vaudeville shows, news weeklies and movies

1978
The Lyric was purchased by New Life in Christ Church and served as a venue for weekly services



Legendary comedian Freddie Roman has been performing on stage since he was a teenager in the Catskills. Beginning his studies in acting at NYU, Roman eventually began touring various theaters in the northeast. The comedian impressed the late, famous Totie Fields one night with his sharp and witty show, and was invited to join Fields on her national tour. This brought Roman into the limelight, and it wasn't long until Freddie Roman became one of the greatest comics of all time. Now, after over half a century working in comedy, Freddie Roman is Dean of the New York Friars Club, the oldest and most influential brotherhood in show business. In addition to standup, Roman has starred in major motion pictures as well as Comedy Central television specials. Roman

starred in his own show *Tonight Live* for a one-year engagement at the Trump Castle in Atlantic City.

Performing alongside Freddie Roman in *A Jew, an Irishman, and an Italian Walk into a Bar* is comedian Jeff Norris. Famous for his ability to emulate a variety of different voices, Norris has performed at venues across the country, including Dangerfields in New York City and The Riviera in Las Vegas. In addition to touring, Norris has also been featured in HBO's series *Oz* and *Boardwalk Empire* as well as appearing in the feature films *My Super Ex Girlfriend* and *Anger Management* starring Adam Sandler and Jack Nicholson. With talk of razing the theater, Friends of the Lyric, a group of concerned citizens, banded together to save the historic structure

MARCH 18, 1988
Friends of the Lyric entered into a contract with the New Life in Christ Church and purchased theater

1993-1995
With assistance from community grassroots efforts and grants, The Lyric Theatre underwent much needed repair from marquee improvements, exterior painting, new roofing and air-conditioning

systems, ADA compliance alterations, box office construction, and remodeling of the restrooms and dressing room

NOVEMBER 12, 1993
The Lyric Theatre was listed on the National Register of Historic Places

1996
New seating installed in the orchestra section and administrative offices constructed

2001
The Balcony of the theater was remodeled for the installation of new balcony seating, an elevator was installed and refurbishment of the lobby and restrooms



2004-2005
The expansion of The Lyric was commenced and completed, enlarging the stage by 14 feet, adding a backstage with flex-dressing area, a restroom, and office/storage areas. The "Star" dressing room also underwent renovation including shower and restroom.

SUMMER OF 2014
The Lyric was closed for substantial renovation as part of the Love The Lyric

Capital Campaign. Lobby and box office improvements, including new exterior and interior entrances, additional Box Office service windows, and bar.
